You've been affected by crime and now your police department is offering you a restorative justice option. What does that mean, and what's next?

Your police department is in partnership with Communities for Restorative Justice (C4RJ), a regional nonprofit serving those affected by crime.

Restorative justice is a way of approaching crime that meets victims' needs and asks offenders to make repair. The confidential process is voluntary and also involves the support of family, community members, and police.
